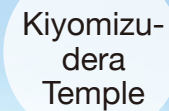

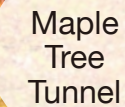

The 8000 Series and the 3000 Series are limited express carriages that make the run between Osaka and Kyoto in the shortest time. There are also Premium Cars, special carriages with fully-reserved seating, in some of these trains.

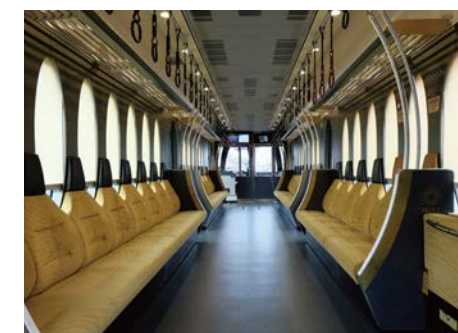
Panorama Train Kirara
